### Daniel 2 and 7

The dream of Nebuchadnezzar [Dan. 2](#)) **Slide 7** [Image of Gold / Silver / Brass / Iron / Iron and clay] covers the same historic order as the beast vision of Daniel, [[Dan. 7](#) [lion / Bear / Leopard / Fourth Beast] **Slide 8** but with this difference: Nebuchadnezzar saw the imposing outward power and splendour [Nevertheless, note how each metal is less precious, yet harder] of the "times of the Gentiles" <sup>1</sup>[Luke 21:24](#); while Daniel saw the true character of Gentile world-government as <sup>2</sup>rapacious and warlike, established and maintained by force. It is remarkable that the imagery shown here of the Gentile nations are all beasts or birds of prey.

**Revelation 12:3** *And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.*

**DANIEL 7:7** *After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.*

**8** *I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things see verse 20*

<sup>1</sup> The "times of the Gentiles" began with the captivity of Judah under Nebuchadnezzar [2Ch 36:1-21](#) since which time Jerusalem has been under Gentile overlordship.

**7:19 Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his nails of brass; which devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet;**

**20 And of the ten horns that were in his head, and of the other which came up, and before whom three fell; even of that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, whose look was more stout than his fellows. See 24**

**21 I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;**

**22 Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom**

**23 Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.**

**24 And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings. See 11:43 But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians shall be at his steps**

**25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time**

The "ten horns" are explained in [Dan 7:24](#) above. They are kings & kingdoms

Now let's go to Rev. 12:1 – 3    3 And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.

Now Rev 13:1 – 3 (esp. 1 *And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.*

Now let's go to Rev 17:1- 3 *So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.*

7 *And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that \*carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns*

\*Carrieth = bastazo = AV -- bear (23) -- carry (3) -- take up (1) [27] 1) to take up with the hands 2) to take up in order to carry or bear

Remember, this “beast” with seven heads and ten horns is the world political power right out of the book of Daniel.

8 *The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, [no foundation – see 9:11 - and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, [13:8] when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.*

9 *And here is the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth.*

10 *And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space. {Roman rulers up to that time. Herod was in office only six months}*

11 *And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition. [Never changes.]*

12 *And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. [Communist dictators. See slides 9 - 11]*

13 *These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.* [God puts it into their hearts just as He did King Nebuchadnezzar. Same purpose.]

14 ¶ *These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.* [19:11,19]

15 *And he saith unto me, The waters which thou sawest, where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.*

16 *And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.* [18:8,9]

17 *For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.* [19:2,3]

18 *And the woman which thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth.*

Now remember our sequence here as related to what we studied already:

Rev. 16:12 – 16 This vial is in fulfillment now, not yet complete.

**Under the 7<sup>th</sup> vial,**

**REVELATION 16:19** *And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.*

**Babylon must receive her just rewards, but we have not been told (in this book of Revelation) who she is, nor how this judgment will be executed.**

**So chapter 17 is inserted here to show us:**

**Who or what is Babylon?**

**She will be in close affiliation with world government leadership (Kings of the earth.) Remember that.**

**She is a whore and has daughters. Children. They are spoken of in Rev. 2:21 - 23**

**Who it is that we are to “come out “ of, as told in 18:4?**

**Who will execute God’s wrath upon Babylon?**

**89 They'll blow that thing off the map, just as certain as I'm standing here. We just had time to take up that subject there of that church, and run it on down through the Scripture, where It said, read, "all the kings of this earth, and all the shipmasters, and all wail, for great Babylon met her desolation in an hour." One hour, her time had come. And, oh, how he said, "Rejoice, you saints, and all you holy prophets, for God has revenged the blood of the saints and your brethren upon her." See, that's right.**
